ONE HARTNELL PROGRESS UPDATES

First Year Experience Task Force

- The First Year Experience (FYE) Framework has been provided to the Steering & Change Management Leadership Team for review and feedback.
- The collected feedback will then be reviewed by the task force, and recommendations will be finalized so approval can be obtained by the Steering & Change Management Leadership Team this month.
- Once approved, the task force will begin to discuss and plan the implementation stage of their work.

Organizational Development Task Force

- The task force is focusing on benchmarking and best practices through in-person and virtual engagements with other institutions that have promising programs to help inform the approach of the task force.
- To further strengthen their efforts, the task force recently welcomed two new members from Counseling and the Student Success Center to gain a broader perspective on their work.

Process Mapping Task Force

- The task force is actively developing process maps, including communication plans, to streamline key milestones in the student journey.
- These drafts, expected to be delivered to the Steering & Change Management Leadership Team this month for review and approval, will provide a clearer structure for guiding students from inquiry to application, application to eligibility, and registration to their first day of classes.

Strategic Recruitment Task Force

- The Strategic Recruitment Plan has been provided to the Steering & Change Management Leadership Team for review and feedback.
- The collected feedback will then be reviewed by the task force, and recommendations will be finalized so approval can be obtained by the Steering & Change Management Leadership Team this month.
- Once approved, the task force will begin to discuss and plan the implementation stage of their work.

Change Management Development Team

- The development team has been actively working to refine communication efforts, including identifying key channels and stakeholders, providing feedback on the *One Hartnell* microsite, and improving the *Hartnell Happenings* newsletter to better reflect Hartnell's voice while simplifying content collection.

The Strategic Recruitment, First Year Experience, and Process Mapping Task Forces all have presented at Academic Senate meetings. The Organizational Development Task Force is scheduled to present this month, and the Data Development Team is being invited for a later meeting.
